

[North West London \(NWL\) Local Maternity System \(LMS\) Update: COVID-19 Vaccination during pregnancy](#)

The North West London (NWL) Local Maternity System (LMS) recommends pregnant women to have the COVID-19 vaccination in pregnancy as per Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation (JCVI) guidance issued 16th April 2021.

You are able to have a COVID-19 vaccination in-line with government priority groups or if you have a health condition or reason that means you are eligible (Click [here](#) for a list of priority groups)

Pfizer and Moderna vaccines are the preferred vaccines for pregnant women of any age who are having their first dose. This is because they have been more widely used during pregnancy in other countries and have not caused any safety issues. (Click [here](#) for full guidance).

Anyone who has already had the first vaccination and is offered a second dose whilst pregnant, should have a second dose with the same vaccine unless they had a serious side effect after the first dose.
