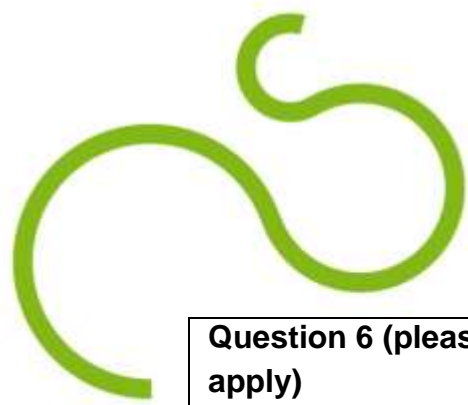
Survey Questions
